Situated 12 nautical miles from Puntarenas, Tortuga Island (called by local indigenous people "Tolinga") has an area of 120 hectares and is maintained as a protected forest, which has been awarded the Ecological Blue Flag for more than five years. This distinction is awarded to beaches in our country that have pollution-free waters. Due to its geographical features, Tortuga Island's waters are clear turquoise, which are optimal for swimming.

The beaches in Manuel Antonio are highly coveted as some of the best that Costa Rica has to offer. On the top of the volcano you can observe the main craters and on a clear day Pacific Oceans and Caribbean Sea. As we descend to the city of Cartago we will stop at the Virgin of the Angels Basilica thar according to religious custom is a peregrination site for many believers. Surrounded by rainforest and lush vegetation..

La Hacienda Orosi has been blessed by mother earth with nascent hypothermal mineral water. These rich springs of mineral hypothermal "telluric" waters (non-magmatic or volcanic), are filtered between the layers of the earth and spring in the middle of the rainforest at more than 65 degrees Celsius.

Grecia is home to one of the only Metal Churches in Central America.

We will also visit the Metropolitan Cathedral.

As we travel around the city, we will point you out several historically important or main buildings in our city, for example The Costa Rica University, The Old Train Station, The National Liquor Factory, The National Supreme Election Bureau, the Asamblea Legislativa (equivalent to The Congress), The Metallic Building, some parks and various sites of interest. This will be an introduction to our Capital City, and information about our economy, cultural, politics, religion and general current events.
